Your support of Big Thicket National Preserve and the National Park Service (NPS) demonstrates an inspiring commitment to preserving the natural beauty of SETX. Your collective contributions meet the spirit of the NPS goal to "connect with and create the next generation of National Park Service visitors, supporters, and advocates."

This project is a great example of a growing community and a committed to ensuring that everyone has a rewarding and educational experience in the preserve. In order to assure maximum safety and accountability, volunteers are required to complete some form(s) BEFORE you do any planting. **ALL** participants **MUST BE** accounted for on a Volunteer Agreement form before participating.

Completing the forms in advance and bringing them with you will make registration run more smoothly. TURN ALL FORMS IN to the registration table upon arrival. The volunteer agreement forms are included in this packet. Complete them using the following guidance:

## 1: ALL PARTICIPANTS (Individuals 18 yrs and older) - Complete a Volunteer Service Agreement (OF-301a).

a) Complete blocks 1-12, 15-19, of the OF-301a.

b) Sign & date in blocks 34 (page 2)

b) The OF-301a is included as a separate attachment with this packet.

## 2: Parents MUST Sign Volunteer Service Agreement (OF 301a) for minors.

a) ALL volunteers under the age of 18 MUST HAVE a completed Volunteer Service Agreement form signed by a parent or guardian.

b) Complete blocks 1-12, 15-19, of the OF-301a.

c) Complete blocks 26-32 of OF-301a.

## 3: If you are a FAMILY or ORGANIZED GROUP:

a) Complete the Volunteer Service Agreement (OF 301a) for 1 person ("Mom" or "Dad")

b) LIST all other family/ organization members on OF 301b

## 4: Turn in ALL forms to Big Thicket National Preserve staff upon arrival at the Planting Site.

Some things to keep in mind:

1. What to Wear/Bring. For all projects, we ask that the volunteers wear long pants, long sleeve shirts, and closed-toed shoes or boots. We also ask that groups come prepared for a day of work by bringing plenty of water, food, a hat and appropriate clothing.

2. **Parents/Chaperons.** Our Project Supervisor will be in charge of the project itself, but parents, group leaders and chaperons need to stay with and work alongside their children & group, and are responsible for discipline. Thanks!

4. **Equipment.** The park staff will provide leadership, tools and equipment for the projects as well as any safety equipment necessary. A short orientation and safety briefing is given prior to your group starting work.

5. **Cancellations.** Cancellations due to weather or other factors will be made 24-hours in advance whenever possible. Notification will be made via telephone, Facebook, website, and visitor center desk.

We're glad you have chosen to volunteer at Big Thicket National Preserve! Our resurging Volunteers-In-Parks program plays a vital role in the preservation and protection of this park, greatly enhancing what park staff can accomplish. You and your group will make a big difference!

## Parking & Driving Directions MLK Jr. Day of Service Site – Big Sandy Creek Unit

This year's planting event is located at the Big Sandy Unit, out by Dallardsville. When traveling to the site, you can follow the directions given in this packet of information or follow the event signs. If you are planning on using your GPS to be directed where to go, make sure you put in 30.641708, -94.660194. The closest town is Dallardsville, Texas.

#### From Beaumont & Other Points South

## Parking

There is limited parking available on-site. We highly encourage everyone to carpool.

Warning: Road surfaces close to the planting site are uneven in places and mostly dirt. They MAY be soft, muddy, or slippery in wet conditions. Plan for self-recovery. The National Park Service cannot provide equipment to help remove a stuck vehicle. Rangers will have contact information for the nearest tow company.

Buses & Small Cars: Look for a ranger to help guide you into special parking zones.

Work Activity Description. Volunteers will engage in tree planting activities as part of the MLK Day of Service and reforestation effort in the Big Sandy Creek Unit of Big Thicket National Preserve. Working in small groups, volunteers will carry dibble bars, planting bags and seedlings, while traveling across uneven terrain, off-trail into a natural unmaintained environment. You will plant tree seedlings into the ground, following the techniques demonstrated during the tree planting training session. Light lifting, some bending and walking on uneven surfaces are required.				
Safety/Protective Gear. This volunteer work may be physically demanding for some people. Your personal safety is our #1 priority. For your protection, everyone should properly prepare for the environment & daily weather. Wear suitable layered clothing for the unpredictable weather conditions cold, rain, sun). Closed toed shoes and long pants are highly encouraged. It is recommended that you bring gloves. If lightening is observed or thunder heard, all work will cease and all volunteers should calmly but immediately seek shelter. Volunteers should take advantage of the water that is provided, ensuring that they stay hydrated. If any item is or appears to be too heavy, you are not required to handle it.
